- AGICOA celebrated 40th birthday in 2021.


Our mission

- We represent audiovisual producers and their representatives.
- We negotiate licensing agreements with the operators.
- We collect royalties from the operators.
- > We identify the audiovisual works used by the operators.
- > We distribute royalties to the producers according to their declared rights.
- > We manage conflicting right declarations.

A Global Presence









In 2023, the AGICOA Alliance achieved **record-breaking** results in both **collection and distribution**, with around **164 million** in royalties collected and distributed to producers.



In 2023, all declarants submitted **90,939 new declarations** of works and rights.

The team also processed over **140,000 rights and 78,000 works updates** to ensure the database remains current.

The automation of Conflict Resolution Procedures (CRPs) has significantly expedited the resolution of conflicts among producers. In 2023, AGICOA initiated 820 new CRPs and successfully resolved 1,523 CRPs, leading to the release of a record sum of over EUR 1.7 million in royalties.

IRRIS: AGICOA's international rights management and distribution system

AGICOA Geneva manages the AGICOA International database of audiovisual works and producer rights, the only database of its kind ensuring the fair management of global audiovisual rights consistently.

IRRIS is **fully developed and maintained** by AGICOA Geneva with **new features and improvements** made available several times per year.
